What was the Recent Year 5/6 Science "Trial Test" About......

The High Performance unit of the Department of Education and Communities is developing an online multimedia interactive assessment for Science and Technology Stage 3 as part of work to expand resources for assessing a broader range of student learning. The test, based on the model of the current Essential Secondary Science Assessment program for Year 8, will provide teachers, schools and parents with diagnostic information and resources for the new K-6 Science & Technology syllabus due for implementation in 2015.

As part of the development, Hannam Vale Public was invited to participate in the first major trial of this new assessment. Our Year 5 and 6 students completed a one hour online Science and Technology test which incorporated videos, audio and graphics during weeks 3 and 4. Feedback should arrive shortly.


STATE ROBOTICS CHALLENGE
