Ideas for Creating a Growth Mindset Environment at Home Part 6: Learning and the Brain

- Talk about neural networking. Ask your child what he or she has learned in school about the brain.
- Whenever you hear your child say, "I give up" or "I just don't get this," remind your child to visualise neurons connecting every time he/ she learns something new. Encourage your child to work hard and practise new skills and concepts so that he can develop strong neural connections in his brain.
- Share with your child some things that you have not yet mastered and your plan for practising and building stronger connections in your brain.

In the kitchen this week we prepared Mie Goreng – Indonesian stir fry, a pear crumble as well as a frittata which was very popular.




While in the garden we concentrated on weeding and tidying up the front and side gardens as well lots of general watering.
