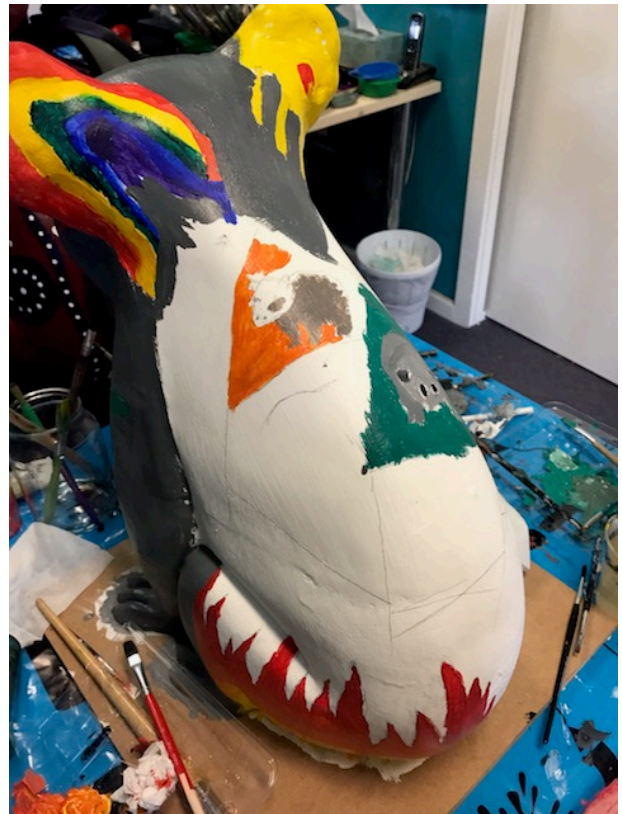


Now that the weather is warming up students need their hats more than ever. Please ensure your child has their hat in their bag ready for playtime and other outdoor activities.

100 Club

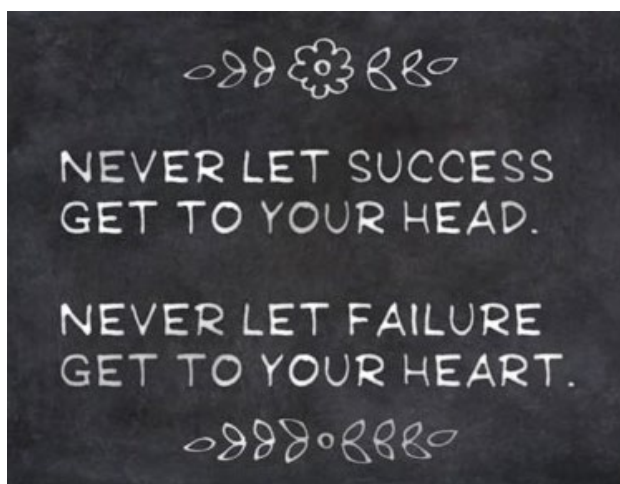
